

ORDINANCE No. 2015-02
Ordinance Establishing 25 Mile per Hour
Speed Zone on South Lawson Drive

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 349.11 (3)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, towns have certain limited authority to set speed limits; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Brooklyn, of Green Lake County, has determined that the actual speed of vehicles on South Lawson Drive is greater than is reasonable and prudent; and

WHEREAS, the Town finds that within any 1,000 feet along South Lawson Drive, the buildings in use for business, industrial or residential purposes fronting thereon average not more than 200 feet apart or where the buildings in use for such purposes fronting on both sides of the highway considered collectively average not more than 200 feet apart.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BROOKLYN, GREEN LAKE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, THAT:

1. The speed limit on South Lawson Drive shall be changed from 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour.
2. Speed limit signs shall be posted in the manner and size required by law.
3. This ordinance shall be effective only upon the passage and publication of an ordinance by the Town of Brooklyn which reduces the speed limit on South Lawson Drive to 25 miles per hour and by the posting of the 25 mile per hour speed limit signs.
